



## Reserved name authorization request procedure

## Exceptions and procedure for authorizing registration or use of Sponsor reserved names

- Under specific circumstances, the Sponsor may, subject to additional policies, authorize registration of .POST domain names using the Sponsor reserved names. Applicants shall submit a formal registration request in accordance with section 3 of the DMP, along with a duly completed Reserved Name Authorization Request Form (see below), in which they shall provide further justification for the release of the reserved name concerned and sufficient evidence that use of that name complies with the legislation or authority to which they are subject.
- The procedure specified in section 1 above shall apply by analogy to formal requests concerning use in subdomains (as opposed to registration) of any of the Sponsor reserved names defined above in section 2, in which case applicants shall be required to submit only a duly completed Reserved Name Authorization Request Form.
- These requests shall be analyzed by the Sponsor, which will inform applicants (either directly or through registrars) of its final decision.
- The Sponsor may, at its sole discretion, decide to allow registration or use of Sponsor reserved names by registrants at specific levels only, taking into account the principles defined in the DMP, as well as relevant intellectual property rights considerations (e.g. the existence of national or international trademarks or joint initiatives for provision of international postal services).
