1 General rules

1.1 Form usage

A CN 60 is generated quarterly by Posts participating in the supplementary remuneration programme. It is based on central monthly reports provided by the UPU International Bureau. These reports are generated from EDI exchanges.

N.B. – Posts participating in the supplementary remuneration programme receive information for both their inbound and outbound exchanges. Information on outbound exchanges should be provided in CN 60 forms generated by partners.

Posts receiving items subject to supplementary remuneration generate CN 60s on a quarterly basis, for each partner from which such items were received in the period.

In case there is mail traffic both ways between two partners, each partner will generate a CN 60 corresponding to the mail received from the other partner.

For settlement purposes, the accepted amounts from CN 60 forms may be listed in a CN 52 general account form.

1.2 Display rules

The following general display rules apply to the form:

- For visual clarity, it is strongly recommended that dynamic content be displayed in a different font from that used for static text (headings, tags, etc.). It is also recommended that dynamic content be displayed in bold;
- Unless specified otherwise, numbers displayed on the form are right-aligned in the cells;
- The decimal separator is a dot (.);
- Numbers are displayed without leading zeros;
- Where no value is available or the value is zero for a cell, the cell is left blank;
- For all numbers with four digits or more, a space is used as the thousand separator: e.g. 12 345.6;
- All amounts are in SDR and have a precision of two decimals;
- When the representation of a numerical value includes x decimals, these x decimals are always displayed.

Important: In a table, all calculations must be performed with the values as they are displayed. If a value is displayed rounded, any calculation using this value must use the rounded value (as opposed to calculations based on non-rounded values, displayed as rounded).

For example, if a calculated weight is 3.36 and it is displayed with 1 decimal, then 3.4 is displayed. If another calculation uses this weight, it must use 3.4, not 3.36.

3 Completion instructions for zones shown in the form

The table below lists the zone numbers appearing in the template on the previous page. For each zone, the label and the completion instructions are indicated.

<i>Zone</i>	<i>Label</i>	<i>Completion instructions</i>
1	Form prepared by	Code and name of the operator generating the form. The code is the 3-character designated operator code from UPU code list 211. The name is the corresponding operator name. The code and name are separated by space hyphen space.
2	Date	Date the form was generated, in format YYYY-MM-DD.
3	Origin designated operator	Code and name of the operator that dispatched the mail. The instructions provided for zone 1 also apply here.
4	Destination designated operator	Code and name of the operator receiving the mail. The instructions provided for zone 1 also apply here.
5	Year – quarter	The format used is YYYY Qx. Example: 2020 Q1
<p>Table: monthly details as provided by the IB Information in the table is ordered by month then product</p>		
6	Column “Month”	The month, in the quarter of the report. It is represented as: – the month number, with possibly a leading zero; – the month 3-letter abbreviation, between parenthesis. Examples: 01 (Jan), 02 (Feb)
7	Column “Product”	The product code and name. One of the following: – L – Tracked – R – Registered – V – Insured N.B. – the report should be ordered alphabetically by month then product. The order is therefore based on the product codes (L, R and V).
8	Column “No. of items”	The number of items to which the remuneration applies.
9	Column “Rate per item”	The rate, as mentioned in the IB report or as agreed bilaterally.
10	Column “Amount (SDR)”	Calculated from the previous columns: Amount = [No. of items] x [Rate per item].
11	Total amount	The sum of all amounts in the form.
12	Observations	Free text observations, if felt necessary.
13	Creditor	Signature of the person (postal operator representative or agent) preparing the form. If the form is generated by an IT system, the signature may be replaced by a printed name or any identifier that allows the person who generated the form to be traced.
14	Debtor Place, date and signature	To be signed manually by the debtor upon receipt of the form, to confirm agreement with its contents. The signed form should then be returned to the creditor.
